GLOBAL ACCESS AWARD

\$3,000* to help students study abroad who are first generation and demonstrate financial need.



Eligibility:

- Member of Academic Advancement Center and/or Community for Excellence
- First in your family to go to college (neither parent has a bachelor's degree)
- Eligible for CSU Tuition Assistance Grant
- Minimum 2.0 GPA and good standing with the university
- Enroll in an Education Abroad for-credit program (list available on Education Abroad website)
- Complete all Global Access Award requirements (see inside)

Note: Priority will be given to students who have not had a prior education abroad experience
